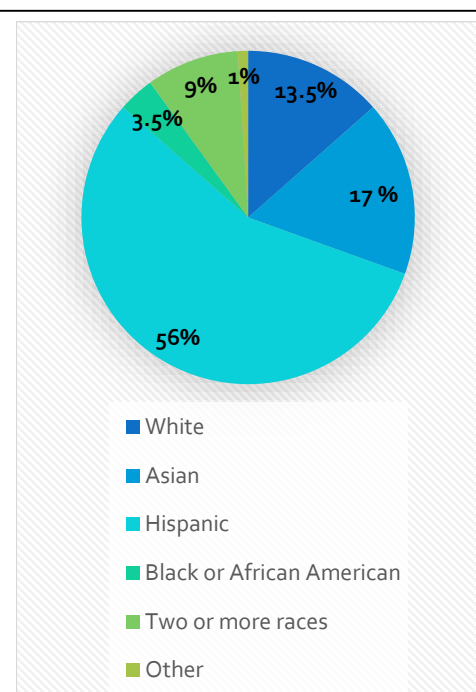

Cumulative Grade Point Average Unweighted: GPA is calculated from grades 9-12, and does not give any extra points.

WEIGHT	Indicates whether mark is the scholastic grade (1.00). Blank spaces indicate the mark is the citizenship grade.
CREDIT	Refers to the number of credits earned for the course. The zero indicator is either the citizenship grade or the scholastic grade if the student earned a F.
