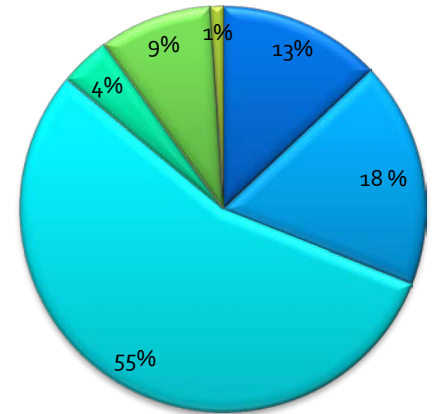

GRADING SYSTEM AND GPA SUMMARY:

Scholastic Grades: Eastlake High School assigns letter grades in all academic classes.

Overall Weighted: GPA is calculated from grades 9-12, and gives extra points for AP/Honors classes taken with earned grades of C or higher.

CSU "A-G" Weighted: GPA is calculated from California State University "A-G" classes taken starting in 10th grade, with earned grade of C or higher, restricted to giving weight to the first 8 weighted classes.

College Weighted Uncapped: GPA is calculated from California State University "A-G" classes taken with earned grade of C or higher, without being restricted.
