A) Social Science: World Geography, World Cultures, US History, Government/Economics	2 years
B) English 9-12 (ELD 7/8 may apply)	4 years
C) Math: Integrated I, Integrated II, Integrated III, Pre-Calculus	3 years (4 yrs recommended)
D) Science: Biology, Chemistry, Physics	2 years (3 recommended of Laboratory Science)
E) Foreign Language	2 years (3 yrs recommended)
F) Visual and Performing Arts	1 year
G) College-Prep Elective	1 year

C. Proficiency in one or more languages other than English

Must meet at least 1 of following:	Proficiency Required
Foreign Language Advanced Placement, including American Sign Language	Score of 3 or higher
International Baccalaureate (IB) Foreign Language course	Score of 4 or higher
4 years of the same foreign language <u>Note:</u> 2 semesters of AP, IB, or 7/8 language courses are considered the equivalent of 4 years of a foreign language. 7/8 language will be evaluated for oral proficiency via a rubric and will need a score of 3 or higher	3.0 GPA or better in reg./ acc./ honors 2.0 GPA or better in AP/IB
SAT II Foreign Language	Score of 600 or higher



Principal Honor Roll Requirements

- ▶ G.P.A. of 3.75 or higher (overall weighted G.P.A. over 7 semesters, starting in 9th grade through first semester of 12th grade)
- ▶ Students must take at least 2 Advanced Placement Courses within the 4 years of high school.
- ▶ Citizenship requirement: Students can only have one D or F in seven semesters of high school.
- ▶ Community Service requirement: At least 100 hours of community service.
